

#### **ORDINARY BOARD MEETING - 22 FEBRUARY 2021**

A meeting of the STCA Board took place on 22 February 2021, the following matters were discussed:

#### **Statewide Waste Communications Memorandum of Understanding**

The Board supported a proposal by the Local Government Association of Tasmania (LGAT) to financially support the continuation of the Statewide Waste Communications MOU. The MOU supports the joint participation of Tasmania's three regional waste management authorities for joint waste reduction and resource recovery communication activities.

#### Community Consultation for the 2021/22 Tasmanian Budget

A submission will be made to the Tasmanian Government 2021/22 budget with the STCAs submission focusing on the key issues of:

- A review of the Southern Tasmanian Regional Land Use Strategy
- Greater support, encouragement and training for employment across southern Tasmania and the establishment of regional employment hubs
- More reliable, accessible and affordable public transport services and infrastructure

#### **Regional Climate Change Initiative**

An update on the Regional Climate Change Initiative (RCCI) was also provided with the Board noting the timeframe for the announcement of the Australian Research Grant. Southern Tasmanian councils were invited to participate in a Regional Climate Change Adaptation Project survey; the survey will help inform the STCA in their preparation for workshops as part of the Project.

#### 2021/22 Projects

The Board discussed the proposed work program for 2021/22. A range of regional climate change projects will continue to progress including the Regional Coastal Hazards Strategy and Regional and Municipal Climate Profiles project. In addition, the STCA will work with Regional Development Australia Tasmania to scope and explore the development of a Regional Economic Development Strategy.

#### **Australian Local Government Association**

It was noted that the Australian Local Government Association National General Assembly is being held in Canberra between 20-23 June. Board members spoke of the benefits in attending the Assembly.

#### Other updates

Updates were also provided on the activities of Destination Southern Tasmania; the Local Government Association of Tasmania and the South Eastern Regional Development Authority.

#### **Financial Report**

The Board noted the 31 December 2020 draft Financial Report. A copy is included with this Quarterly Report.

#### **Next Meeting**

The next Board meeting will be hosted by Huon Valley Council and will be held on 17 May 2021.
